The hull was repainted, and has flaws and runs in the job, along with some small dings and peeling from poor prep. The upper decks (green) as well as the cat walks, need to be repainted, as they were never completed. Then engines turn by hand, with a wrench and compression is evident, although unmeasured. I am currently seeking to replace both carburetors with marine carbs (Quadrajets) as the carbs on hand were automotive. One engine needs an impeller, and one exhaust hose I am confident to get the engines running soon. Should that happen, the price will go up to reflect it. The price is based on a sliding scale as to the amount of work, time and money I put into her.

She is a great boat, with lots of needs. She does float, and has 110v shore power (Updated 110v and 12vdc breaker panels with meters as well as dual batteries. However, She is in no stretch of the imagination ready to go cruising until some work is done. Shipping is available but cost is the buyers responsibility. (I have a connection on this)
