This was the last of several boats he restored during his lifetime, and she felt a sentimental attachment to it, but after five years decided to pass in on to someone else that would appreciate it for what it was. They called it a Gale boat, but I am not sure that was the hull maker, as my research on the internet has never produced a Gale Boat. I think the dash control panel for the Gale Sovereign 35 engine may have made them think it was also the mfg. of the boat. Maybe? Her father spent three years restoring it and the work really shows. That was 6+ years ago and it has always been stored inside, under wraps. The top side is two species of wood; I believe they said it was mahogany and spruce. It really makes for a great two-tone look on the deck and transom. The engine is the original 1960 with electric choke and starter, and it runs great. It has two deep cycle batteries, battery switch, and onboard charger. With a full gas tank (14 gals.) and two adults, the boat topped out at 27 mph."
