No trailer included but was moved to my property on a large 24' trailer. Purchaser is responsible for picking up and moving the boat. A 32' x 15' x 12' shelter is also available if you want. 1936 POOLE 24'. Owner says, "The engine is a Chevy 153 "Iron Duke" 120 HP driving a velvet drive transmission. The boat is solid Teak with very little rot above water line, all repaired or replaced. Hull has been re-screwed and sealed, although this is still a challenge getting everything to seal as it's on a trailer... Poole was a manufacturer of approximately 55 boats in the 1930s' probably no two alike. One story I had seen, said Poole built his boats in the North West. I don't believe there is any connection with Poole in England. This model 24 foot solid teak boat was built in 1936. All the fittings are either brass or bronze. I purchased the boat in 1992 from a boat club member who had seen her in Mission Bay a year earlier. In 1993 some basic repairs were started, but the purchase of a running Chris Craft halted any significant work. Serious work on the boat did not start until around early 2000.
