She has raced in many Columbus Day Regattas in Biscayne Bay, Miami, First Boat at Coral Reef Yacht Club. She is in good shape. Kubota Diesel is a few years old, less than 100 hours. **FREE 1960 MANSON 30'.** Owner says, "These boats were built in Salisbury, MA. She was a grand boat in her day. The boat is my Dad's and he bought it in the mid 90's, used it until 2002, and it has been sitting since. There is substantial wood rot throughout the boat; the worst seems to be the transom which has come apart on the port side. The exterior will need a lot of structural work but it is still repairable. Fiberglassed cabin roof. Owner says, "No rotten wood. Engine removed, needs rebuilding. Boat completely restored in 1970. The bottom needs recaulking.
