1959 MECHANIX ILLUSTRATED PLAN BOAT. The idea for WALTER'S DREAM originally came from the February 1959 issue of Mechanix Illustrated bearing the title: Build This Cruiser For Less Than \$300. The article "Build Barnaby" by Hank Clark appeared in the Boats and Boating section of the publication and began with these words: "This is it! For less than \$300 – \$233 to be exact – I built this 16-foot cabin cruiser. Framing lumber for the hull cost \$43; plywood planking \$80; miscellaneous wood, screws and paint \$64; control hardware \$46; total cost for the hull, \$233." *(continued on page 3.)*
